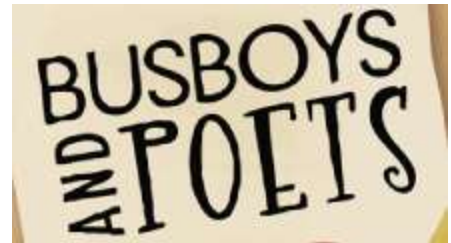

STARTER

Busboys House (Vegan/Gluten-Free) - with baby kale, carrot and jicama tossed in yuzu vinaigrette

ENTRÉE (Choice of One)

___ Fried Chicken (Gluten-Free) - herb cornmeal-encrusted chicken breast with a chardonnay cream sauce; served with mashed potatoes and collard greens
